GIANT VIKING TOWER

The Giant viking tower is named after the vikings who understood how to use wood in large scale and the Viking ships is a very good example of their craftsmanship. The Gian viking tower is made from only the best materials and carved with great precision.

The game consists of 60 mahogany blocks finished by skilled Filipino craftsmen.

Objective of the game

Build a tower of the mahogany blocks and take turns in removing one piece at a time and place it on top of the tower. The first person to tumble the tower has lost.

How to Play

You can either play the game in an easy way or increase the difficulty.

The easy way to play the game is to place 3 pieces evenly spaced in 20 layers. Take turns in removing a piece and add it to the top of the tower without the tower falling. The player who tumbles the tower has lost It can grow quite tall.

The more difficult way to play the game is the same as above, but with the first 2

layers containing only 2 blocks each.

Build the rest of the tower using 3 blocks

on each level with a gap between them.

Blocks can only be touched with one hand. Limit the turn to 20 seconds. Once you have touched a block it must be removed. Blocks should not be taken from the top 2 layers (too easy)

Safety

Leave plenty of space around the game to allow the blocks to fall.

Children should be supervised during play children under 8 years must play with adult supervision due to the tumbling tower.

Do not remove blocks from the bottom 2 layers or the tower will fall.
