The game consists of 60 mahogany round wooden sticks finished by skilled Filipino craftsmen.

How to Play Lokes tricky sticks is like the game of Jenga, just upside down, the object is to build a tower from the bottom and work your way up without making the tower fall.

Lokes tricky sticks is a fun and entertaining game which can be played alone and by two players.

The round wooden sticks is placed on top of each other in rows of two sticks and if you are two persons playing the game, you will take turns at placing one stick at a time. The Lokes tricky sticks can grow quite tall, and that's why you have to take precautions. It is important that you find an even surface for this game otherwise the tower will be very hard to build.

Safety Leave plenty of space around the game to allow the sticks to fall.

Children should be supervised during play
Children under 8 years must play with adult supervision due to the tumbling towers

All players not taking a turn and spectators should keep a safe distance away from the game.
